Screening events were boosted by the addition of first year media archives student, Micah Gottlieb, to the Student Chapter. Micah came into the program as an experienced film programmer and was able to coordinate a number of co-sponsorships between the Student Chapter and Melnitz Movies for archival screenings that took place in the James Bridges Theatre on campus. Prints for those screenings came on loan from the UCLA Film & Television Archive and USC Hugh Hefner Archive. It was a great way for the Chapter to showcase the work that archives do.

The Chapter sponsored tours, successfully fundraised, and held quarterly meetings. Members garnered exceptional internship opportunities to build skills and implement class learning into hands-on, practical workflows.

A great many things were planned for the Spring quarter, but the COVID-19 lockdown meant that some plans had to be jettisoned while others migrated into an online environment. In particular, we established a series of virtual Brown Bag talks and took advantage of the remote environment to connect with archivists nationwide.

During our Spring quarter meeting, we determined that Micah, Brian, and Megan will spearhead the Student Chapter in the upcoming 2020-2021 academic year, and they will determine how they would like to structure the organization going forward.
