2017 Goals Completed

- Maintain Committee Websites
- Support Exploration and Expansion of AMIA Scholarships and Fellowships
 - Organized the George Blood, L.P. Women in Audiovisual Archiving Scholarship. This scholarship was designed to facilitate the advanced education and training of women who wish to pursue careers in technical areas of audiovisual archives. It is a one time award of \$4000 and is available to both full-time and part-time female students.
- Complete and Launch Student Chapter Handbook
 - Student Chapter Handbook- Launched
 - The Guide contains three sections: *Starting a New AMIA Student Chapter* ; *I've Started a Chapter, Now What?* ; and *Student Report Guidelines and Tips*. This Guide is currently hosted on the AMIA Education Committee site

- Mentorship Program plan for 2018
 - There have been mentorship programs in the past, pairing up students and professionals at the conference, but that fell off
 - Students and Newcomers aren't sure what to expect from the AMIA Conference- a Conference 101, or way to ask conference veterans what to expect before they arrive would be helpful
 - Newcomers want more transparency and understanding of committees, what they do, and who the leaders are- many didn't get a chance to talk to chairs at the Newcomer's Mixer

 - Students would like to find a way to connect with professionals who have the same interests
 - Students and Newcomers would like to have a mentor throughout the whole conference, to ask questions prior to the conference, and also while at the conference
